Notes:

1. Showroom stock is being integrated into the 2017/8 season to bring a modern cost effective approach to stock class racing in NZ. This closely aligns with international trends allowing the NZJSBA to promote a competitive stock class racing platform. Provision for 2016 NZJSBA stock class will be made for one year by integrating this with some Showroom stock classes (separate trophies may be awarded depending on numbers competing).
2. Additional classes may be considered if minimum of 5 entries are reached. Application should be made to hosting club prior to event with proof of entries.
3. New Zealand Jet Sports Tour is a 6 round tour, hosted over 3 events. Points will be accumulated from each round and overall placings will be awarded at the conclusion of round 6.
4. In the interest of competitive racing, where possible, classes may be combined to ensure an adequate number of craft in races.
5. To foster the future of the tour and sport, if a rider makes the effort to attend the event and races, points will be awarded in their entered class regardless of the number of craft in the class.
6. The NZ Tour will follow the 2016 IJSBA Rule Book and any supplementary rules as implemented by the NZJSBA.
7. If you are unclear about any rule, it is the responsibility of the rider to seek clarification from the appointed NZJSBA technical Director and/or NZJSBA executive committee.
8. All riders are required to familiarise themselves with said rules before competing.
9. All Junior/novice or 1st time riders should make race organisers aware of their intentions to race prior to the event and may be required to undergo pre race training with an appointed NZJSBA representative.

11. The entry fee for the NZ tour will be payable to the hosting club of each event. The fee is set at \$30 per class Per round payable over and above the hosting clubs local round fee.
12. All competitors must adhere and abide by the NZJSBA code of conduct at all times. This also applies to pit crew and supporters at each event. A copy is available on our web site.
13. To be eligible to race in the NZ tour, competitors MUST comply with NZJSBA licensing regulations. To be awarded overall points for the NZ Tour you must hold a full NZJSBA license (no day licenses allowed). A rider may be able to compete at the local club event on a day license and not generate points towards the tour.
14. Proposed Racing Schedule: This may vary with each event locations requirements... competitors should seek clarification on each tour event entry form for exact requirements; 8am – 9am Registration and Scrutineering, 9.30am Riders briefing, 10.00 am Course induction, 10.30am Racing commences.
15. Each NZ Tour will consist of 4 rounds of racing per day.
16. Pole Ski riders: The wearing of back braces is now mandatory in racing at all events
17. Veterans: Riders must be 35 years or older to enter Runabout, 30 years or older to complete in Ski. ID may be required
18. If there is sufficient interest in Women's Classes or Ski 750, these classes will be offered on the day pending adequate numbers. NB additional classes must show significant support across multiple rounds to be included into tour trophy/prize eligibility. Please contact NZJSBA to register interest in additional classes.

DIRECTIONS TO THE LAKE

Access to the venue is easy. Directions from Waipukurau

1. Head west on Ruataniwha St toward Northumberland Street. **Travel 400 m**
2. Turn left onto State Highway 2. **Travel 10.2 km**
3. Turn right onto Speedy Road. **Travel 1.4 km**
4. Turn left to stay on Speedy Road. **Travel 1.7 km**
5. Destination is on the right.

Accommodation is available in nearby Waipawa, Waipukurau and Dannevirke, check out booking.co.nz

NO DOGS ALLOWED

HBJSC are putting on a BBQ dinner Saturday Night – no charge

There are supermarkets, cafes, takeaways 10 – 15 minutes away in Waipukurau and Dannevirke

This is a privately owned lake that we only have closure for from 8 am till 5pm Sunday, lake time for tuning, testing / repairs etc will be available on Saturday at the completion of racing with approval from the race director



The pre-race schedule for the day is as follows:

7.00am – 9.00am	Registration and Scrutineering/ Safety Checks
9.30am	Riders Briefing – attendance is compulsory
10.00am	Course Induction
10.30am	Racing Starts

SCRUTINEERING

Your vessel and race gear will be scrutineered to ensure they comply with the NZJSBA racing criteria. You will personally need to wear a compliant helmet and life vest (PDF 3 or 5) and have a tow loop attached to your ski. Pole Ski riders must have a compliant back brace. It is also recommended that riders wear footwear, wetsuit, goggles and gloves, and have with them, a fire extinguisher. All skis will also be scrutineered for safety prior to racing.

RACE LICENSE

All competitors must hold a current NZJSBA Race License. A Full season NZJSBA Race License costs \$140.00.

If you are applying for a license for the first time please bring along photo ID for officials to view.

If you are under 18yrs, your license must be signed by a parent or guardian.

SKI NUMBER

All skis must clearly display a large, legible race number on both sides of their ski. To find what race numbers are available please contact Russell Thorogood at info@nzjetsport.org.nz. New riders, please do not use single digit numbers or numbers 11 or 111.

FIRST TIME RIDERS

First Time Riders are only eligible to enter Novice Class and must present a stock ski that complies with the NZJSBA Stock Rules. Maritime rules state that all riders of PWC must be over the age of 15 years unless an exemption has been granted. Call your local club for more details.

Prizegiving will be on site at the conclusion of each race day
