

# South Island Jet Sports Champs 2020

The CJSC welcome you to the **South Island Jet Sports Champs.** We would like to take this opportunity to thank our event sponsors, volunteers and the committee of The Canterbury Jet Sports Club.

### **Entries**

All entries must be received by the due date, 12<sup>th</sup> February 2020. Final orders for trophies will be placed immediately after this time... entries received after 12/2/2020 will still be accepted but will face late fees and may not receive trophies if minimum class numbers were not reached before 12.2.2020.

Should minimum class entry numbers not be reached by 12/2/2020 we will advise you of options or you can choose to forfeit your entry.

We strongly recommend you bring a ski trolley/stand or old carpet piece to pull your ski out of the water. There will not be enough beaches for all competitors to leave trailers in the waters edge. Skis are not permitted to be left in the water between races.

Ezi up style tents are the best form of shelter to use on site. The ground is very stony and pegs are often unusable. All tents must be suitably secured against wind elements with weights.

# Lake Roto Kohatu is leased to the CJSC by the Christchurch City Council, and accordingly all competitors must abide by the following regulations;

- There will be limited trailer parking at the waters edge. Please advise CJSC if you require assistance with trolley/stand options. Trailers are to be left in the designated areas.
- Absolutely no refueling in the water. Refueling is restricted to the pit area away from the waters edge.
- The grounds are largely unsuitable for erecting tents due to the hard-stony surface. We recommend Ezi up style tents secured by weights.
- No leaflets or flyers are to be handed out to competitors and/or spectators without the prior consent of the CJSC.
- There is no Overnight security, you are required to pack down all equipment at the conclusion of each days racing.
- Av Gas is available to purchase at Challenge Waimak.

#### Food

The CJSC, in association with "Hellers" hosts a BBQ each race day for competitors, pit crew and officials. Sausages and bacon with bread and sauces will be available during the lunch break. You will need to bring all other food with you. A coffee vendor will be on site each morning. There is a Z garage with café and Burger King within a short distance of the lake.

#### **Accommodation**

We recommend staying at the 'Race Course Hotel Motor Lodge', 118 Race Course Rd, Yaldhurst, Christchurch. Ph (03) 3427150 or <a href="mailto:enquiries@racecoursehotel.co.nz">enquiries@racecoursehotel.co.nz</a>

They have excellent rates, family style restaurant, bar, sports bar and plenty of parking and are 8 minutes drive from the race site. Prize Giving will be held at the Race Course hotel on Sunday night. If you choose to book at other motel/hotels we advise you check the availability of safe off street trailer parking.

## **Registration and Scruitineering**

Registration and Scrutineering will take place from 8am on the morning of each race day at the race site. You will be required to register on each day you intend to race.

CJSC plan to open the track for controlled look laps in the afternoon of Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February. This will be strictly controlled by CJSC and is **NOT** considered race practice... rather a chance to familiarize you with the track plan.

All competitors are required to be on site a minimum 1 hour prior to riders briefing each day that they are racing unless stated by the Race Director. All riders MUST attend the official riders briefing on the day they are racing, no exceptions.

Remember to carry your NZJSBA or international race license with you. You will need to present this to a CJSC official at registration.

#### **Prize Giving**

The official prize giving ceremony will be held at The Race Course Hotel Sports Bar and will include a light meal. Tickets for prize giving must be pre-purchased. Cost per person is \$25. You must be present to claim prizes, trophies may be shipped if necessary.
