# 2021/2022 SEASON - CLASS UPDATE

# October 28th, 2021

The NZJSBA Executive Committee met recently to discuss the classes offered at national level for the coming season. Comprehensive discussion took place and the following classes and changes have been agreed on by the NZJSBA EC for the 2021/2022 season.

All the below classes will be offered at the 2022 New Zealand Jet Sport Nationals. Unless otherwise agreed all classes require a minimum of 5 entrants to run on their own. A minimum of 3 entrants are required for classes to run in a combined format.

An NZJSBA Open Class Licence can be obtained by completing the appropriate Open Licence application form and submitting it to the NZJSBA Office. The application **must** be made and approved prior to attending any sanctioned events.

Notably the Executive Committee have voted to introduce a "Ski Four Stroke" class that will act as a transition/introduction class for the two current Four Stroke Ski models that are on the market — the Kawasaki SX-R 1500 and the Yamaha Superjet 1050. The Kawasaki will run to the IJSBA Ski Stock rules in this class and the Yamaha will run to the IJSBA Ski Four Stroke Lites rules. Overall awards will be presented along with awarding the top rider competing under the Ski Four Stroke Lites rules — this is to recognise the performance difference between the craft.

### **SKI - ELIGIBILITY**

Updates to eligibility were voted on in respect to new/current Four Stroke Ski craft being permitted to enter into the Ski GP class. The following was ratified with respect to the Ski GP class only:

- The Kawasaki SX-R 1500 is eligible to enter the Ski GP Class. It must conform to IJSBA Ski Stock rules when doing so. It cannot be modified to Ski GP rules.
- The Kawasaki SX-R 1500 hull cannot be utilised as an "aftermarket style" hull under the Ski GP rules (i.e. alternative homologated engine/pump packages cannot be fitted to it). All "aftermarket style" hulls must conform to a maximum of 97" in length.
- The Kawasaki 4-cyl 1500 engine cannot be utilised in any "aftermarket style" hull irrespective of modifications. It can only be used in an OEM Kawasaki SX-R 1500 hull.
- The Yamaha Superjet 1050 can be modified to meet Ski GP rules and compete in the Ski GP class.
